Books (usually written and developed specifically to support book-banded guided reading) are graded into appropriate levels, or Bands, in order to provide children with appropriate books to read. Originally there were eleven Book Bands, and each was denoted by a colour, as follows: Pink Band (the 'lowest'), then Red , Yellow , Blue , Green , Orange , Turquoise , Purple , Gold , White and Lime (the highest band).
