This wood can be found in different grades from AA (low grade) to AAAA (high grade) to master grade (highest grade). The costs of these woods can vary, especially when considering exotic wood. Tonewood traditionalists will usually stick with a few tried and tested types of wood for each part of the guitar. For the most part, acoustic guitar builders will use mahogany or maple wood for the neck of the guitar; sitka spruce of western red cedar for the top; and mahogany, rosewood, maple, or ...
