A right triangle is a triangle in which one angle is a right angle. The relation between the sides and angles of a right triangle is the basis for trigonometry. The side opposite the right angle is called the hypotenuse (side *c* *c* in the figure). The sides adjacent to the right angle are called legs (sides *a* and *b*).

Draw a right isosceles triangle and label the two leg lengths *x*. Then draw the altitude to the hypotenuse and label its length *y*. Now, use the Right Triangle Similarity Theorem (Theorem 9.6) to draw the three similar triangles from the image and label any side length that is equal to either *x* or *y*.
